Gift Aid Appeal

Having examined the continued growth in parishioner's
generous financial contributions to the Parish, for which
we are very grateful, the Parish now claims over
£35,000.00 from the treasury in Gift Aid each year.

Whilst the Parish is able to claim a limited amount of Gift
Aid from the loose plate, (Money donated without an
envelope), it may be possible to claim a further £8,500.00
per year if parishioners who pay tax on their earnings or
their savings, not using the envelope system were willing
to consider using it in future.
