Blessing of the Graves will take place after 11am Mass on Sunday 22nd June.

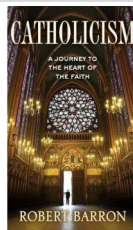
Holy Water bottles will be placed on each grave for a family member to bless their own family grave. Please leave the Holy Water bottles on the graves for next year.
